

**LUBRIZOL ADVANCED MATERIALS, INC.
FLOWGUARD® BENDABLE PIPE
LIMITED WARRANTY**

Lubrizol Advanced Materials, Inc. ("Lubrizol") warrants that FlowGuard® Bendable pipe, when properly installed by a licensed professional following Lubrizol's published installation standards applicable at the time of installation, including, but not limited to, the proper use of the required sleeve fitting, to be free from defects in material and workmanship for 10 years from the Installation Date. This warranty is provided to the initial purchaser of FlowGuard Bendable Pipe and is freely transferable for 5 years from the date of first installation of FlowGuard Bendable Pipe; thereafter, this warranty is not transferable.

This warranty does not extend to any installation that is not intended for the delivery of potable water or is not in compliance with local codes or has not been installed by licensed plumbers/plumbing contractors, and any such installation voids this warranty. LUBRIZOL'S LIABILITY UNDER THIS WARRANTY IS LIMITED, AT LUBRIZOL'S OPTION, TO THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF THE DEFECTIVE FLOWGUARD® BENDABLE PIPE. Lubrizol shall not be liable for consequential, punitive, special, or incidental damages based upon breach of warranty. Such damages include, but are not limited to, damage to property, loss of profits and/or other economic loss. This warranty does not cover and specifically excludes: damages resulting from physical abuse; acts of God, including damage due to frozen water; damages resulting from rodents or contact with materials that are chemically incompatible with CPVC.

Immediately upon the discovery of a leak or other system failure, the owner must contact Lubrizol, and unless Lubrizol directs otherwise, it is the responsibility of the property owner to obtain and pay for the repairs to the failed part(s). Only if the warranty applies will Lubrizol be responsible for any reimbursement under this warranty. The part(s) which you claim failed should be kept and Lubrizol contacted by writing to the address below or by telephoning 888-234-2436, Ext. 447-7393 within thirty days after the leak or other failure. You should be prepared to ship, at your expense, the product which you claim to have failed due to a manufacturing defect, documenting the date of installation, the date the problem was discovered, the date of repair, and the amount of any claimed payments for which you seek reimbursement, along with the detailed records of invoices and payments. Within a reasonable time after notification, Lubrizol will investigate the claimed failure, which includes the right to inspect the products at Lubrizol and reasonable access to the site of the damage in order to determine whether the warranty applies. Lubrizol will notify you in writing of the results of its review. If the conditions of this limited warranty are met, Lubrizol will reimburse the cost of the part(s) and will pay reasonable direct labor charges for removal and replacement of the failed part(s). THESE ARE THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDIES FOR BREACH OF THIS LIMITED WARRANTY.

It is expressly understood that authorized Lubrizol sales representatives, distributors, and plumbing professionals have no express or implied authority to bind Lubrizol to any agreement or warranty of any kind without the express written consent of Lubrizol.

THIS LIMITED WARRANTY is in lieu of all other warranties and Lubrizol Advanced Materials, Inc. makes no other warranties, expressed or implied, including the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. As permitted by law, Lubrizol Advanced Materials, Inc. does not intend to include in this Warranty damages or injuries to persons or personal property resulting from any claimed defect in material or workmanship.
